L106016 Rifleman Kenneth Edward Toles was born in 1910 in Ontario. He enlisted with the Regina Rifles on the 21st of May 1943 at the No. 12 District Depot in Regina Saskatchewan. He would serve in Canada, the United Kingdom and in continental Europe. Having taken part in the North West Europe Campaign. Kenneth would be wounded in the upper arm/ shoulder but would return to duty and would go on to serve until he was discharged on the 8th of February 1946. For his service to Canada, he was awarded the 1939-1945 Star, the France and Germany Star, and the Canadian Volunteer Service Medal with Overseas Clasp. Kenneth passed away on the 3rd of April 1994 and was buried four days later in Plot: LS 134-B-1 at the Sunset Cemetery in Moose Jaw.
