Swift Current Legion Branch #56 Chase the KING Draw

SLGA Lottery Licence #RR26-0275

1. Tickets are \$2 each
2. Winner gets 15% of the weeks' sales as a consolation prize-if the Jackpot is not won by drawing the **King of Diamonds**.
3. 35% gets added to the jackpot until the King of Diamonds is drawn
4. 50% goes to the Royal Canadian Legion Branch #56
5. You must be in Saskatchewan when you purchase the ticket, and the holder of the weekly winning ticket must be present to claim prize. If there is one other name on that ticket as a "Purchaser-Chosen Proxy", then that person must also be present and may pick up the winnings on their behalf. The weekly winning ticket number will be called up to five times in 15 minutes. Failure to present the winning ticket within fifteen minutes, shall result in forfeiture of the prize, and an alternate draw shall be conducted.
6. Ticket sales are restricted to those **19 years of age and older**.
7. A maximum of 25,000 tickets may be sold. The total prize value awarded under this licence shall not exceed \$50,000.
8. A standard deck of 52 cards will be used. A new deck will be used after the King of diamonds is drawn.
9. Tickets will be sold at the Royal Canadian Legion Branch # 56 at 239 1st. Avenue North Swift Current, lower lounge.
10. Weekly ticket draw takes place every Friday from September 11, 2026 – September 10, 2027, at Royal Canadian Legion Branch # 56 at 239 1st. Avenue North Swift Current, lower lounge. at 6:30 p.m.
11. Tickets can be purchased up to 30 minutes prior to the draw on Fridays at Royal Canadian Legion #56. All eligible tickets purchased during the draw week shall have an equal opportunity to win.
12. Weekly ticket sales distribution:
 - a. 15% goes to the winning ticket holder as a consolation prize if the King of Diamonds is not drawn.
 - b. 35% adds to the jackpot if the King of Diamonds remains undrawn.
 - c. 50% is allocated to the Royal Canadian Legion Branch #56.
14. The entire deck will be shown to display the King of Diamonds prior to the draw.
15. Weekly draw winner wins 15% of the weekly sales as a consolation prize by cutting the standard deck of 52 cards. If the King of Diamonds is chosen from the deck of cards, the winner gets the jackpot, which includes the 35% of ticket sales for that week and any carry-forward of previous week jackpot. If the King of Diamonds is not drawn, the selected card is removed from the deck and the 35% goes into the prize pot for the next week's draw.
16. To start off the Chase the King Draw, the Royal Canadian Legion Branch #56 will enter \$700 into the Jackpot. After the first jackpot has been won, all other jackpots will start at zero and build up from the weekly sales only. If the King of Diamonds is drawn at the very beginning, the winner will be awarded the jackpot of \$700 plus the 50% of all the ticket sales for the week prior. The other 50% of those Legion, et sales will go to the Legion and the jackpot starts at \$0.00 again. The next jackpot is built up again from the weekly sales and so on.

17. At the end of each week's "cut the deck" segment, the rest of the deck will be displayed to show that the King of Diamonds is still in the deck.
18. The remaining cards from the standard deck, shall be sealed in an envelope by the Royal Canadian Legion Branch #56 members in charge of the draw.
19. Contest continues with the same standard deck of cards until the King of Diamonds is drawn.
20. Once the King is drawn, a new contest begins. The Jackpot resets to zero, and a new deck of cards will be used.
21. Only tickets sold during the current week are eligible for that week's draw. All previous tickets sold will be removed at the conclusion of each weekly draw.
22. No limit on the number of tickets that can be purchased for a draw. Exception to this rule will be the final draw on September 10, 2027, where tickets are limited to 10 tickets per person.
23. **No refunds will be allowed for any tickets purchased.**
24. **No receipts will be given for any tickets purchased.**
25. There is only one name per ticket allowed, **unless there is also a "Purchaser Chosen Proxy" written on the ticket.**
26. The Royal Canadian Legion Branch #56 members, all volunteers and the immediate family ARE allowed to purchase tickets. The person(s) cutting the cards and drawing tickets are NOT allowed to participate.
27. Beginning on Friday, September 11, 2026, the raffle will continue until final draw Friday, September 10, 2027.
28. Total ticket sales for the duration of the lottery shall not exceed 25,000 in number. In the event that all tickets are sold before the September 10, 2027, date, the draw will take place the Friday that the final ticket is sold, with the Winning Ticket Holder receiving 15% of the weekly sales and will be given a chance to cut the deck of cards for the King of Diamonds. IF the ticket holder does not cut the King of Diamonds, they will keep the 15% of the weekly sales, with the remaining 35% to be added to the Jackpot, and another ticket will be drawn. Tickets will continue to be drawn, until a ticket holder cuts the King of Diamonds from the deck of cards, who will then receive the Jackpot total that has accumulated to that time, bringing this Chase the King event to its conclusion. (If the ticket holders do not cut the King of Diamonds after the consolation prize has been awarded, there be no other consolation prizes awarded.) The person who cuts the King of Diamonds will only be entitled to the 35% portion, or the "Jackpot".
29. Depending on the value of the prize pot, the winner may be required to come to the Royal Canadian Legion Branch #56 Office in Swift Current during office hours with ID to claim winnings in form of a cheque.
30. Winner's cheques will be ready within 3 business days.

Payout Plan

In the event that ticket sales of 25,000 have not been reached by the Licence Expiry Date of Sept 10, 2027:

The winning ticket holder will receive and keep 15% of the weekly sales. If the King of Diamonds is drawn by this ticket holder, that ticket holder shall receive and keep the 35% of the weekly sales as well as the 15% and the Lottery is over.

If the King of Diamonds is NOT drawn, the ticket holder will keep the 15% consolation prize. A new ticket holder will then draw for the King of Diamonds and there will continue to be a new ticket holder until the King of Diamonds is drawn. No more consolation prizes will be awarded to them.

The final winner will receive 35% of the weekly sales (the Jackpot). The Lottery is over
